

PROTEST

On 24-25 June 2025 in Stuttgart, a delegation with representatives of the Danish Government and CSS project partners will try to convince delegates from Germany, Austria and Switzerland to export their CO2 to Denmark by pipelines and ship.

We protest against

that the Danish Government, with reference to the Paris Agreement and the Danish Climate Act, is starting an unsustainable business adventure that, to become a financial success, requires large amounts of CO2 to be imported from abroad

... and hope that Germany, Austria and Switzerland will find their own solutions to meet their own climate goals and not rely on a solution that

- is strongly opposed by Danish citizens
- has been brought about without providing adequate information to the Danish public – and using a questionable democratic processⁱ
- requires the construction of a potentially dangerous infrastructure that locks in a bad climate solution, CCS and unsustainable use of biomass, and for financial reasons forces everyone to continue with these solutions, even if better solutions are available

We protest against

that it is even considered to store CO2 under inhabited areas, and that it is even contemplated to go directly to full-scale operation without a test phase

... and hope that Germany, Austria and Switzerland will show solidarity with the Danish population and not contribute to risky and unnecessary projects being launched with their CO2 as an important part of the Danish plan

We protest against

that, with this plan, an irreversible process is started that, based on an insufficient analysis of the risk aspects, potentially exposes Danish citizens to danger now and for many, many years to come

... and hope that Germany, Austria and Switzerland completely refrain from contributing to this very questionable project, or – if it is decided to contribute after all – that it is under the strict provision that it must not be stored under inhabited areas or Natura2000 protected areas.
